



PUBLISHING GUIDELINES - Story Studios Australia - FAN-tastic Fiction

A digital publication of fan-fiction stories written by the young writers enrolled in a weekly Story Studios Australia Creative Story Writing Group or Mentorship.

Term 1, 2024

Who can enter:

Submission to the FAN-tastic Fiction digital publication is open to young writers enrolled for Semester 1, 2024.

Submissions will open on Monday 4 March, 2024 Submissions close end of the holidays - Saturday 13 April 2024 at 11:59pm.

Rules:

Entries that fail to meet the following criteria will not be accepted:

- 2000 word limit
- Your entry must be a new and original fan-fiction story (please see Story Studios definition of fan fiction below:

Fanfiction is a story based on characters or settings originating in another work. Story Studios Australia's take on fan-fiction is that it is a NEW story (i.e. plot, adventure etc) about characters and/or places from a famous story. It is a chance for fans to place their favourite characters into new times, places and situations, add new characters to a story, or even add themselves as characters!

- You are only permitted to submit one story.
- Stories should be something you have worked in with your mentor during your weekly sessions.
- Submissions must not contain any strong language, strong violence or gore.
- Submissions must not be offensive or rude (a little bit cheeky is fine). We recommend ambiguity and subtlety for any stories dealing with darker themes and references!
- The story needs to be an original work (no assistance from parents, teachers, Al etc.) and should not infringe on a third party's intellectual property rights (fanfiction is fine, copying lines from their story is not).
- The entry must be unpublished (either in print or online).

How to enter:

- All stories must be submitted in font Arial size 12 with 1.15 spacing
- All stories must be submitted as a Word. PDF or Pages document.
- Entries should have the following details on the top of the submission:
- author's name (first and last)
- date of birth
- the title of the story
- the story yours is derived from or inspired by
- Title the subject of your email 'Fan Fiction Entry Writer Name'

Terms and conditions

- 1. Young writers submitting their stories consent to have their work published on Story Studios Australia/Melbourne Young Writers' Studio social media, promotional material, website and our digital publication.
- 2. Young writers may only submit one story for publication.

- 3. Submissions are final. No changes to young writers' work will be accepted once submissions are made. Any feedback should be sought during weekly story writing groups/mentorships.
- 4. Story Studios Australia reserves the right to request proof of identity, proof of enrolment or booking, and proof of submission validity.
- 5. Story Studios Australia reserves the right not to publish stories that do not meet the criteria.
- 6. Publication is subject to approval by Story Studios Australia.
